It has been a busy time at the National Office with the successful transfer of the office to our new purpose built facility at 12 Sladen Street, Hamlyn Heights. The new facility is clean, practical, and far more efficient for the Fellowship and its members.

The National Office was used as the venue for our most recent National Board meeting on the 13th and 14th of August 2010. The feedback from the Board on the new office was extremely positive and they were most impressed with the size and quality of the office, book room, and storage area.

I would personally like to thank the members, partners, and Chapters of the Fellowship who through their monthly giving or their generous donations have made the new office a reality – Praise the Lord!



Celebration BBQ

On Saturday the 6th of November 2010, the Geelong Chapter hosted a celebration BBQ at the National office. About 40 people attended on a most beautiful and sunny afternoon. This was an opportunity for many FGBMFI members to see the completed office and grounds.

We were privileged to have long time FGBMFI member and spiritual mentor Major Alan Laurens share a message about the importance of the Fellowship's work around Australia. He then prayed a blessing over the new National office, dedicating it to the Glory of God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Rental Blessings

We are already seeing the benefits of not having to pay a property owner a monthly rental lease of \$1,400.00. The rental lease money saved amounts to at least \$16,800.00 a year.

The FGBMFI organisation does not have to pay a rental lease at the new office at 12 Sladen Street. We hope to stay at these premises for at least 5 years.

The savings will initially be used to pay back the interest free loan used to build the office and to support additional FGBMFI outreach around Australia.

The interest free loan should be repaid within 18 months. Then all rental lease savings can be fully used to fund and support additional FGBMFI Outreach around the nation.

In past years, it was necessary to place a levy of \$100.00 on every active FGBMFI Chapter in Australia to help cover Public Liability Insurance for the Fellowship meetings at Chapter level. To encourage local Chapters who may be struggling financially at present, the National office will not apply a \$100.00 levy on Chapters in 2010.

The rental savings has allowed the National Office to fully pay the Public Liability Insurance without a Chapter levy for all FGBMFI Chapter meetings or gatherings till the 30/09/2011. Praise the Lord!

Office Computers

The new office computers and colour photocopy machine which was provided by the generous donations of FGBMFI Chapters and members are being put to good use. The office computer has been used to produce a promotional flyers for the last two Naracoorte Outreach breakfasts.

The colour photocopy machine was then used to print good quality colour promotional A4 sized flyers, which were used to advertise the breakfasts. The Naracoorte Chapter is to be congratulated for organising two outreach breakfasts and for making use of the office equipment.

When I flew back from Adelaide to Avalon, an announcement came over the speaker that there was a delay and people would have to wait for their luggage. You should have heard the winging and complaining. "It's taking just as long to get our luggage as what it has to fly here." When I thought once again of that poor woman in Africa, I shook my head and thought to myself, "They don't know they're alive here."

Help us to have really grateful hearts Lord, and thank you even for the small mercies. Give us the strength we need to press on and really pray for this Nation that it will be turned around and fulfil the plan you have for us, that we may truly be known as the 'Great South Land of the Holy Spirit.'

A successful Parliamentary Prayer Breakfast, now in its third year, was held. The team then went to the local nursing home, where Major Alan Laurens was able to minister to over 30 residents. Well done to Ray Hungerford who organised this most productive day for the Kingdom of God. The Lord is touching lives for the Kingdom through the FGBMFI ministry.

The **Traralgon Chapter** has continued their monthly outreaches as informal breakfast meetings. A number of non-Christians were in the thirty to fifty people that came to hear a businessman, a unionist, and an entertainer share their stories. There was also a special meeting for prospective members.

Two regular weekly prayer meetings, one during the day and the other at night, have added great strength to the Chapter. We

are glad for our faithful praying members. As men called to this ministry, and working closely with our state and national leaders, we are looking to the LORD to do what only He can do in reaching the people of our valley.

DVD MINISTRY

The Adelaide North DVD ministry was created in July 2007.

This all came about when I attended a men's breakfast in Salisbury, South Australia. Glenda Watson, a white South African, was the guest speaker. At the breakfast I had given away about 15 testimony DVDs.

One of the guys asked me, "how do you do your dvds"? "One at a time in the computer" I replied..

He then said, "You can get a stand alone duplicator that can do multiple copies" "What's that cost?" I asked. "\$2000", he said.

As I am a pensioner I thought that was beyond my means, but God had a plan.

The thought God dropped into my heart was to find 10 Christian businessmen that would donate \$200.00 each. Within 6 weeks I had the necessary amount and thus a God given idea came into fruition.

Thus DVD Ministry was created. Never in my wildest dreams could I comprehend what God would do. Since that time I now have a library of approximately 150 testimonies on DVD and feedback from numerous places throughout the world.

Where our DVDs have been seen when I started I was giving away DVDs in a plain white cover and God told me I was a lousy salesman. We have a good product but no way for people to contact me.

Quite often we do this when we are sharing the gospel with a friend. We tell them about Jesus but we don't seal the deal. Let's remember to seal the deal. So since then I have my e/mail and contact info on the paper sleeve.

I haven't sent any overseas, but they have travelled to numerous parts of the world. For instance one of my African friends from church took 18 discs to South Africa. His brother is the supervisor of a school in Durbin. He duplicated the discs and sent them to schools all over Africa. with instructions to copy and send them on.

Rod Winter early this year took 200 discs into the Sudan. Paul Munn has done 9 trips into Cambodia with numerous DVDs for the pastors of that country. The Lutheran guys went to the Philippines on outreach and DVDs were given away there.

Mike Flynn from the Adelaide North East Chapter got a surprise phone call from his brother in New Zealand, whom he had not had contact for many years, to say that he had seen Mike's story on DVD.

And so it goes on. The Adelaide North Chapter has been the instigator of creating a world wide DVD ministry that has gone into places that we would never have dreamt of. They are made round to keep going around.

From the beginning in July 07 to the end of September 2010 we have purchased 12,000 blank DVDs. To all those that have assisted in any way to make this venture a success, I wish to extend a big thank you, especially to God for a good, God given idea.
